**Once again it is time for the illustrious 'CHEESE HEADS' to plan another get together (this marks the 21th year of this annual event). Eric Van Miller has once again offered his facility for our meeting at his office in Green Bay. So make your plans to attend the Advanced Biomechanics XXIII Course. For participants of previous 'Biomechanics' courses this program will be a combination of clinical techniques with direct correlation of specific treatment problems through the use of case presentations.**

As you know for the past few years I have ask the group to submit ideas for topics for the next year's course. This results in numerous request to answer specific questions regarding specific treatment problems and I have attempted to group these together in order of the most requested items. Additionaly, I will be presenting more cases under the category of 'Why did/is this not work/ing??' as well as cases entitled 'How could this be done better??' Some of the most popular/frequent subject were: tips for dealing with ankylosed deciduous teeth, treatment sequence for impacted

cuspid, treatment of reverse crossbite, 'thin slicing' missing upper lateral incisor cases, problems and treatment solutions associated with malposed second molars. Another common request had to do with extraction cases and more specifically which teeth to take out and when (including management of congenitally missing teeth in extraction cases). Other questions related to changes in aligner treatment and technology, use of elastics during finishing and simple solutions for minimal relapse cases where things didn't work out as planned. Additionally, there was the request to see more tips on practice management and inventory challenges for the non-specialist office. So this year's seminar will seek to address these items (including answering many of the specific questions that were asked). See the list of 'Clinical Learning Objectives' below.

**Multiple cases will be utilized to demonstrate various aspects of mechanics and treatment modalities with particular interest paid to the best available 'evidenced based information'.**

**Additionally, multiple treatment 'pearls' will be shown to make your practice easier and more efficient.**

**This will not be a repeat of last year's information.**

### **Participants Case Consultations**

Participant's individual cases will be reviewed at 5:00PM on Friday and 1:00PM on Saturday after the course. *Please respect the 2 case maximum.* Should you decide to bring the records on a case from your office, be sure that it has been completely traced, analyzed, and treatment planned prior to our discussions. In order to give you an opinion, it is necessary that you present complete and accurate records, and that you follow the "analytical and cephalometric guidelines" previously set.

## Some of the Clinical Learning Objectives (Lecture Style Course)

- 1) Treatment sequence for impacted cuspids.
- 2) 'Thin Slicing' aligner technology including mixed dentition treatment, 3D printers and digital monitoring.
- 3) How to decide which teeth to remove in an extraction cases (when and why).
- 4) 'Thin slicing' missing laterals and treatment decisions??
- 5) When is it time to take the braces off???
- 6) Learn multiple 'pearls' for practice management of orthodontics in a non speciality practice dealing with patients and parents and supply inventory.
- 7) Dealing with malposed second molars (impacted, rotated, cross bite and reverse crossbite).
- 8) Periodontal and mucogingival problems including frenectomies.
- 9) Relapse solutions and retention protocol, results and criteria.
- 10) Multiple individual topic including: midline correction, phase I treatment goals (who should and shouldn't be treated), different expansion appliances dealing with tooth size discrepancies.
